This application relates to section 36, Schedule 2 of the Industrial Chemicals (Consequential Amendments and Transitional Provisions) Act 2019.

- To approve your application, we must be satisfied that your commercial interests will be substantially prejudiced if we publish the chemical's identity on its Inventory listing.
- Giving false or misleading information is a serious offence. We may pass on the information in this form to other agencies as authorised or required by law.
