- You can submit a joint application, but we can't process the application until all applicants submit their own form.
- The **applicant must submit this form** through AICIS Business Services. An agent cannot submit this form on behalf of the applicant.
- If some of the information cannot be disclosed to the applicant, the chemical data provider can email the confidential information to applications@industrialchemicals.gov.au.
- Giving false or misleading information is a serious offence. We may pass on the information in this form to other agencies as authorised or required by law.
